

Scholarship Program

The Juliette M. Atherton Scholarship was named in memory of Mrs. Atherton to ensure the continued association of her name and her special interest in Christianity with the Foundation. The scholarship benefits three categories of individuals: dependent sons or daughters of ordained, active Protestant ministers in Hawai'i pursuing undergraduate studies; individuals from Hawai'i pursuing graduate theological studies at a Protestant seminary with the goal of ordination; and active, ordained Protestant ministers residing in Hawai'i seeking an Advanced Degree. Scholarship recipients are selected based on their financial need and academic promise.

For the most recent academic year, scholarship awards totaled \$107,000 to 23 students. The Foundation also awarded a grant to support the Stronger Together Hawaii Fund of the Hawai'i Community Foundation.
